WHY SAFELAND USA?

- Over 80% of oil and gas operators across the country require or accept the SafeLandUSA Orientation
 - More than 1.4 million workers have successfully completed the program

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Bakken Region Overview course is an add-on module to PEC Safety's Basic Orientation. The purpose of this course is to inform workers of hazards specific to the Bakken Shale Play area. This 1-hour module discusses the Bakken Region, sources of oil extraction common to the Bakken Region, the properties and characteristics of Bakken oil, and hazards specific to the region.
